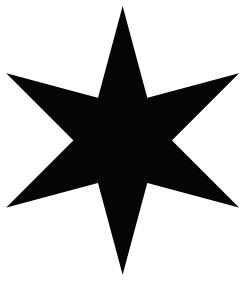
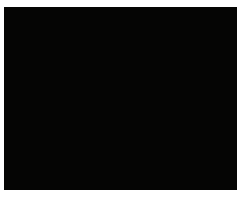

It's a summer of pride! Disability Pride Month begins on July 1st and the Paralympics will start in August!

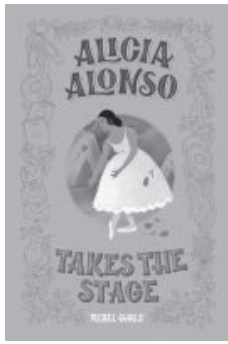

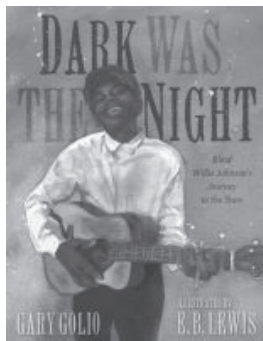
